Minutes of Meeting

Call to order: 7:00 PM

- 3. Brian informed the members about a tour he had taken of the Old Academy Building with Roy Brown from Roy S. Brown Architects. Brian indicated that a report on the structural needs of the building would be forthcoming from the company. The report will guide town committees in coordinating efforts and funding to remediate OAB problems such as mold.

- 4. Discussion on future Historical Commission goals.
 - a. Randy suggested that the stone wall across from the Stowell Building needs repair. Could the commission look into finding a stone mason?
 - b. Kay suggested the need for re-establishing the "Plaque Program" to identify the year historical buildings were built.
 - c. Kay also shared an idea for a possible commission project. She had attended a tour of different old buildings in a local town entitled: Hilltown History Trail and thought that a similar tour of New Salem buildings could be a worthy project.
 - d. The members discussed the overarching goal for this coming year is to organize and prioritize the commission's projects. Included in that goal was building consistent communication with various town boards such as the Swift River Museum, New Salem Library, and the Old Academy Trustees.
